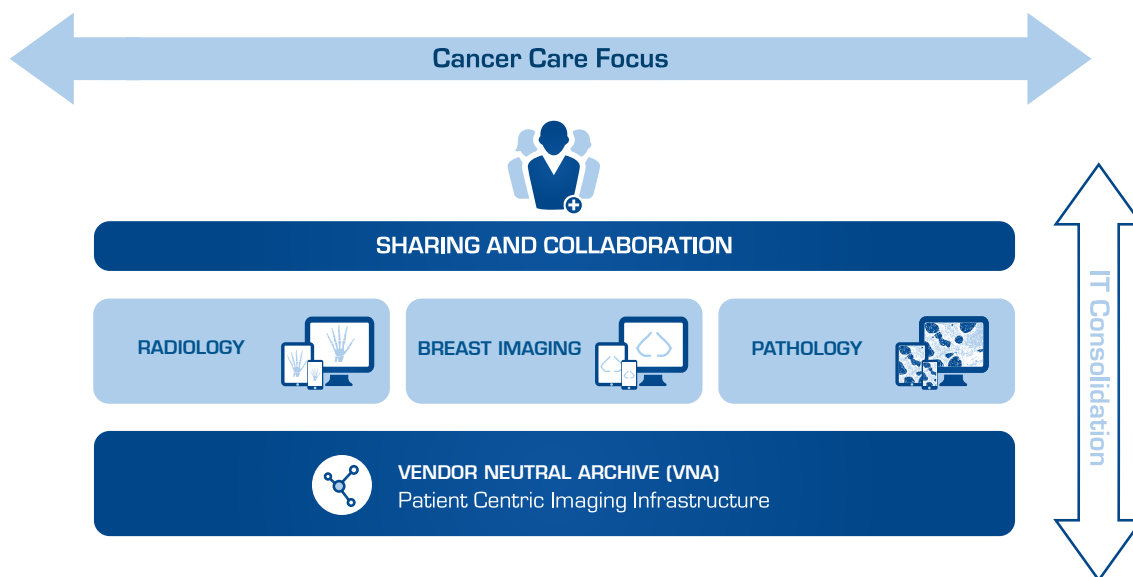

As healthcare becomes more oriented towards clinical pathways, access to images and information created along the patient pathway is key. Thanks to Sectra's experience in both data storage and workflow solutions, we provide a cost-efficient VNA solution that will not compromise your clinical workflows.

Designed for easy capture

Sectra VNA facilitates the capture of medical images, film and audio clips from virtually any source, including ECG, HD film, non-DICOM images, which also encompasses pathology images, as well as all DICOM SOP Class images. Images may be DICOM-wrapped or kept in their original format, allowing you to choose the optimal strategy for each department and workflow.

The capture is easily achieved by either integrating existing image management solutions from any standard compliant vendor, or with Sectra's built-in import interface. Sectra's solution makes it easy for clinicians to import relevant images to the system, allowing a common storage of patient data for future reference. The import interface is designed to make the capture of images, video and audio as smooth as possible for users along the patient pathway – while meeting the clinical challenges of different departments. The Sectra import interface can be launched directly from the patient record, enabling an EMR-driven workflow. Patient and examination details are automatically pre-populated, avoiding double data entry for improved efficiency, quality and safety.

Single point of access

Sectra's solution facilitates access to and exchange of all relevant information across the entire clinical pathway. Authorized users have access to a comprehensive multimedia record through a universal viewer. Alternatively, departmental solutions such as PACS can easily retrieve images from the VNA.

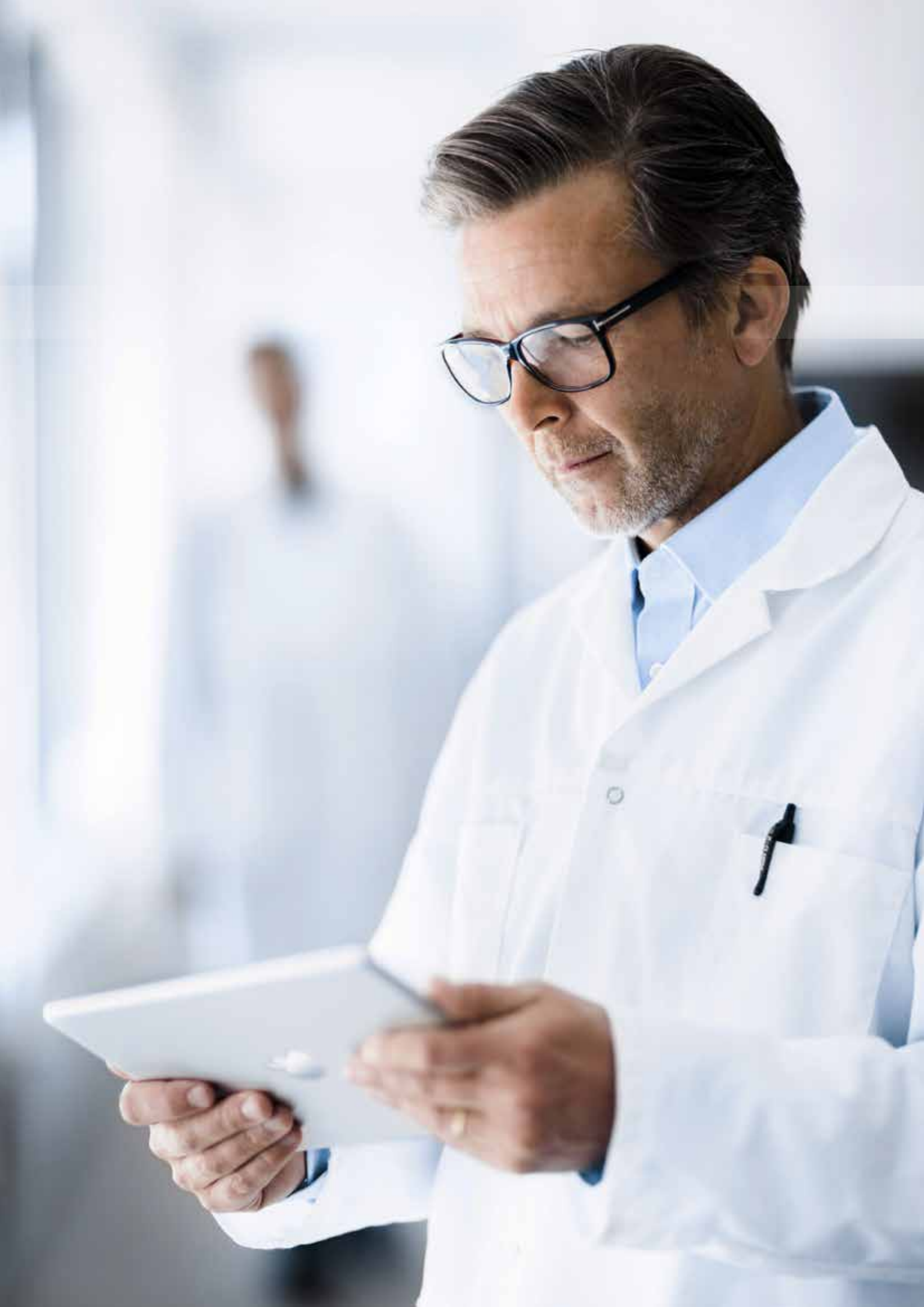
The viewer is available in a variety of designs – from a zero-footprint tablet viewer, to advanced diagnostic workstations. Technologies such as high-performance streaming and wavelet compression facilitate multi-site workflows across wide-area networks.

Sectra VNA features an interoperability platform and task manager, which improves communication between the VNA and surrounding systems such as RIS, EMR, PACS, etc. Based on the characteristics of incoming data, it can launch different tasks such as linking patient MRN domains.

When consolidating the enterprise archive, it is vital to ensure that the workflow in image-intensive departments – such as mammography, pathology and radiology – continues to function smoothly. Sectra offers not only extensive archiving experience; we have also provided complete workflow solutions for more than 30 years, adapted to the needs of each clinical discipline.

Data analysis for an optimized clinical workflow

Sectra's VNA offering provides the means to fine-tune clinical workflows through efficient data mining and management reporting tools, using either your existing data mining applications, or applications provided by Sectra. The data is stored in a separate warehouse, which allows for secure data extraction without affecting the production systems.

Scalability and system elasticity

A VNA is a long-term investment. Over time, your storage strategy may change. The amount of data you need to store will most likely grow, with new departments added along the way. A storage agnostic archive

Sectra's VNA is designed to meet both today's and tomorrow's storage needs. The amount of data stored in medical archives is increasing rapidly as higher resolutions and new technology emerge. Take pathology, for example, which is about to be digitized in many countries. This will require extensive capabilities for dealing with huge amounts of data – with single files often as large as 1 GB.

Sectra VNA is storage-neutral, supporting your existing or future storage strategy – regardless of your choice of vendor and whether your storage is local, central or cloud-based. This gives you freedom when the time comes to expand storage.

Sectra VNA also features sophisticated Information Life Cycle Management (ILM), taking into account clinical relevance, file age and last access, allowing you to increase the cost efficiency of your storage.

Flexible delivery models

Sectra VNA supports various delivery models – from traditional on-premise installations, where you are responsible for the hardware platform, all the way to software as a service (SaaS) delivered from fully managed off-site data centers. The cloud-based delivery model makes the VNA extremely flexible in terms of scalability. The result? Reduced need for continuous capital investments, and a much smaller storage footprint on-site.

Supporting mergers and acquisitions

In a growing organization, mergers and acquisitions could further amplify the need for expanded storage capabilities. Consolidation is often the long-term goal, but in the short-term that might not be possible. Sectra VNA offers the means to both share data efficiently between different systems, and to migrate other archives in a structured way. The migration tools available in our VNA allow you to increase the speed of data transfer during off-peak hours, for example, and assign higher priority in the migration queue to data used in ongoing care processes. This ensures you maintain the same performance and quality of service during data migration as you would during normal operations.
